

OCTOBER 11, 2010 MINUTES OF THE FINE ARTS BOOSTERS MEETING

The Gilbert Fine Arts Boosters meeting was held in the high school's ICN room, since there were volleyball games going on and the commons was too noisy. Members present included Mike and Natalie Haverdink, Leigh Adcock, Carrie Thimmisch and new member Leann Meehan. President Jay Heydlauff attended the second half of the meeting. Secretary Melinda Luzbetak was unable to attend the meeting but visited briefly with Natalie prior to the meeting, and with the board at the end of the meeting. None of the faculty were in attendance at this meeting.

The board informed Leann of the purpose of FAB, and also discussed the Community Facility Committee's (CFC) last meeting.

Lance Gardner and Jeff Becker from the Gilbert Athletic Boosters stopped in to discuss the CFC meeting as well. They wanted to clarify FAB's position on this matter and encouraged FAB to keep looking for options where both athletics and fine arts can get what they want in Phase 1 of the building project.

Melinda created an "Auditorium Survey" to be used when FAB members or fine arts staff are visiting or interviewing other auditoriums outside of our district. FAB members provided comments and Melinda will make changes and send it out to members along with the minutes of the meeting. Please feel free to begin using the surveys if anyone has the opportunity to see or call other schools' auditoriums or multipurpose facilities. No FAB visits have been scheduled as of yet; prospective schools and visitation dates will hopefully be discussed at the next meeting.

Mike gave the treasurer report, including a printout of the fall financial activity report. He stated that FAB gave Chris Covell the money (\$500) to go towards the second-hand vibraphone but that he is unsure if this instrument has been delivered to Gilbert yet. The All-State campers were each sent a check for \$50 as promised, to reimburse them for part of the cost of camp. Mike said that Kaaren Rogers will get back to him on the sheet music for the Simon Estes Concert; we have agreed to reimburse her for the cost of the sheet music as there was no money in the vocal music budget for this. We have still not received the Scrip money. The ticket taking money was received (\$3100.00) and deposited. We have received 27 new FAB memberships this fall, resulting in approximately \$2825.00 in income. It was mentioned that we should send out a second letter to ask for more booster donations.

The Simon Estes concert was very nice, it was reported. Approximately 10 Gilbert students participated.

Jay is coordinating the half-time refreshments for the 7th/8th grade band students for the football game Friday October 15. He has some food lined up and may make a few more calls.

All-State vocal auditions are Saturday, October 23 in Indianola. Brandon Thimmesch, Erica Graber, Carrie Goossen and Jared Haverdink are auditioning. We are unaware if any band students are auditioning for All-State.

Leigh is working on a display board for FAB membership to set out on a table at the Fall Play (Nov. 12/13). Carrie Thimmesch is helping. Melinda will provide Leigh with a photo CD from the last musical, to add to the pictures for the display board. We will also have fliers there for Scrip (instructions for parents on how to get started). Natalie will contact Pam Vandenberg to see if those fliers are still how we order Scrip.

At the next meeting, we need to discuss refreshments for the play. Pamela Covell has requested pizzas for one of the play rehearsals. **The next FAB meeting is on Monday, November 8 at 7:00pm.**
