

Meeting minutes for May 18, 2017

Present at meeting: Angela Shaw, Jen Weber, Shelly Billings, Layne Billings, Byron Tinder, Karen Wickert, Lauren Borg (later)

April meeting minutes approved. No Treasurer's report. Reported preliminary Large Group contest numbers - \$3,339.15 Gross, \$2,426.17 net; we had 1,112 participants, 9 schools, served 500 main dishes, 500 treats, 400 drinks – this really is a 2-person job. We are not going to host for 2017-18.

Diane has asked for reimbursement from bank for refused checks (due to bank error in printing new checks). Cash flow concerns when hosting these large events, possible solutions – 2 people with checkwriting abilities, debit card – issues with reconciliation and receipts – will explore next year with new board.

Concessions are completed – new manager is LeAnn, redeemables are still proceeding, we will need someone to take this over next year.

Scholarship committee presented 4 scholarships to Angela Schwartz, Steven Shuka, Noah Brinkmeyer, and Quinton Nespor.

Nominations for officers had some discussion about having co-treasurer, co-president, final decision at next meeting on June 1st. Angela will approach potential candidates to be officers for next year.

Mr. Tinder reported on Band – Chicago trip will be June 12th-June 18th. There is a rehearsal at 8 AM on June 1st with band/choir trip meeting and we agreed to serve donuts and juice for 100 kids. There will be a 3 day band camp this coming August as Marching Band will perform on the 2nd day of school. Mr. Tinder requested \$2100 for garment bags to hold the band uniforms. This was approved. Mrs. Rogers (through Jen Weber) requested reimbursement for choir All State camp at \$75 per student. Jen motioned, Byron seconded. Motion carried.

SCRIP meeting with Cherie Torresi went well as Gilbert Education Foundation is taking over. Plans are underway to promote the program and at this time, parents will receive 50% of the rebate and Fine Arts and PTO will get 25% each. As the program is no longer run through the school, parents are able to use the cash balance for any expense but are specifically encouraged to use to save up for items such as driver's education, Washington, DC trip, band/choir trip, etc.
