

September 14, 2017: Fine Arts Booster Club Meeting

1. Minutes were approved for August meeting.
2. Funding requests: on website we have put our funding requests and they will be approved by the principal and then we will consider them as they come forward.
 - a. Byron Tinder requested 1000.00 to continue to update music library. This was motioned and approved.
 - b. Jen Maguire, from H.S. art requested a replacement motor and flexible shaft for Jewelry class (cost: 330.00), this was motioned and approved. Also she requested a group of art posters, "Elements of Design" set to replace the old ones she currently has. This would cost about 60.00-70.00 dollars, and was approved.
 - c. Krissy Leinen, also from H.S. Art requested a shelf for her kiln. A student broke one last year and she would like to replace it. The cost is 50.00 and this was approved. Also she requests a display case for fine art in the school, and had a sample for us to look at from online site: Dick Blick. We discussed the need and possible location of this display case, and considered how the athletics have a substantial case in the lobby, cafeteria area. This display case would be glass enclosed and hopefully lit. We spoke about funding coming from PEBBLE grant or school. We will discuss further and get back to her on a decision.
3. Membership: We currently have 21 members with a total donation of about 3600.00 so far. We have passes to hand out to those that become members of the FAB. We have a little bit more this year compared to last year's numbers.
4. Treasurer's report: Mike can back up Diane and even cover payments if Diane is unable to do it if absent. IRS 990 was filed and mailed: as we are an organization that raised less than 50,000.00 last year or consistently. Currently we have 20,648.00 in our account. Pay pal takes about 2.6% for payments made online.
5. Other Business: Laureen will check with Leo about the Redeemables for the musical set costs. Students can possibly volunteer time and assist with the set and design costs.
 - We spoke about the senior recognition for the marching band this year. Usually there are vinyl posters put up on fence of all the seniors for the last home football game, and then at halftime, the band is recognized with parents. The pregame recognizes the football players and the cheerleaders, and maybe the cross country athletes. We have 19 seniors in our marching band this year. If a parent would like to do something more like decorate band cubbies, etc....they sure could. Please contact Byron prior to doing something extra.
