3. **Treasurer's Report:** Thank you to Diane who put together a whole year (July 1- June 30, 2016) of our financial activity for us to look at. Our ending balance was: September 8 - 19,931.12. Our estimated payments for the month of September are about 8300.00 with a balance of 11,652.00 in account. Paper notes will include these financial statements.
4. **Old Business:**
  - Our brochures are good to copy and hand out at fine arts events at school. Good for the freshman night at High School next year.
  - Membership is at 20 so far this year.
  - Website updates: FAB 2500.00 given to the website work at the High School. We will link to our own website, where people can read the details about the Fine Arts area of our schools. Mike Haverdink is tracking this program for us. Thank you Mike!
  - Concessions has been going well, we have one short this week, at the time of our meeting. All Slots have been filled well for the football season.
  - Redeemables: February, March and April will go to After Prom and November and December will go possibly to the Dance Team. The summer months went to FCCLA and Mrs. Pohl would have September and October. FAB would like some months as

well, to help our budget out. Leo Timms has been tracking this program for us.

- **Uniform pants:** we ordered two drum major pants for 100.00. This was ordered last spring, we got them in and needed to return one pair for new size, so we will wait for final invoice.
- **Marimba:** We have the opportunity to buy a marimba that will be used by the All-State band this fall. Mr. Tinder is able to pick out the one he wants, and he has chosen a good one for about 5100.00 from West Music. This is a reduced rate after the All-State concerts. Thanks to Pam Vandenberg and (Therese Baker) who put their script money into this instrument, we have the balance to pay. This motion was put forward and approved to purchase the marimba.
- **A donation form** to fill out for teacher requests will be created, to help with our accounting and support. This will be a PDF to teachers which will help the treasurer and our meetings for board action.
- **New Business:** November 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> will be this year's Variety Show. We are excited to have our students shine in this fun and well done show!
- **Band and choir trip** this year will be to Chicago again. The trip is set for June 2017 and we are waiting for official approval. The travel company is Bright Spark which is the same one used for the Washington DC trip. There will be fun in the mix of the trip as well as fine moments of performance.
- **Additional requests:** Zach Hackbarth presented to the board and others the hope to begin an acting/drama club at our school. He anticipates 15-20 students and this would include a full membership to the Theatrical National Society (Thespian Club) Troupe. We would offer a scholarship through the FAB not just for actors but for stage crew. This club would inspire leadership, increase participation in theatre work, workshops, and festivals. We will assist with the startup costs for the students interested in joining. The board approved the payment of 85.00 a year for membership and 50% of each student fee for the next two years. The acting/drama club will actively fundraise to make money toward self-funding.
